



Bulk Water Purchasing Policy for Citizens

Sale of Bulk Water to residential customers shall be available with the following conditions:

- Functioning fire hydrant belonging to the town must be located within a reasonable amount (to be determined by Norwood Public Works Director) from customer desired end location.
- Over exposure of risk of town owned property may prohibit town providing bulk sale of water (to be judged by Norwood Public Works Director).
- Commencing delivery of water for bulk sale dependent solely on Norwood Public Works schedule and work priorities.
- Cost is based on water prices of regular water customers with outside customers being charged outside rates and inside customers, inside rates.
- Customer is responsible for any damage to the town's meter or hydrant due to tampering.
- Customer shall not install, uninstall, adjust, or in any wise tamper with meter unless directly permitted and instructed by Norwood Head of Public Works or his or her designee.
- Cost is the amount of water delivered plus \$65 fee for installation, uninstallation, and monitoring.
- A \$200 deposit is required before service can begin.
